#### CHRISTMAS AND CHANUKAH GIFTS FOR OUR HOSPITALIZED VETERANS.


You bring 'em,



Do you remember why you became an Elk? Some people might say it was for social reasons. It's nice to have a place to meet with friends, have a few drinks, and perhaps watch a sporting event on TV. Other people may have joined the Elks because they were interested in a particular Elks activity: veterans, youth, community awareness, etc. Regardless of your reasons, your Lodge can use you help. An Elks Lodge relies on its members to participate in the affairs of the Lodge, and a great way to participate is to become an officer of the Lodge.

You may say that you don't have time to be an officer. Well, it is true that being an officer of the Lodge does require a commitment, but it's not a difficult as you think. You must attend all regular meetings, but that's only twice a month. You must attend an officer's meeting, but that's only once a month. You must attend all mandatory special events, but we only have two: Flag Day and Elks Memorial Service. You must attend ritual practice, but that's only one night a week and only for a limited number of weeks during the year.

In February, our statutes require that we nominate and elect our officers for the following year which begins each April 1st. However, not all officer positions are elective. Several officers are appointed by the Exalted Ruler: Tiler, Inner Guard, Chaplain and Esquire. These are generally considered to be the entry level positions where a member can experience being an officer before deciding to run for an elected position.

Before you dismiss the idea completely, why not talk to someone who has been an officer already. There are many members who are Past Exalted Rulers (PERs) and who can advise you and answer any questions you may have about being an officer. Elsewhere in this bulletin, there is a complete list of all the PERs. Please take the time to approach one of them and discuss what it means to be a Lodge officer. You have nothing to lose, and you and your Lodge have everything to gain.
