December 23rd which happened to be "Elks Bingo Night" at St. Albans. Needless to say George *had to be* at St. Albans that evening to hand out Christmas/Chanukah gifts to the patients. It is this dedication that warranted George Butler's selection as the Elks New York State Male Veterans Volunteer of the Year for 2012-2013. This was a well-earned and justly-deserved award. 


