Saturday, June 14<sup>th</sup> was the official date that America celebrated Flag Day. New York Lodge #1 held a Flag Day celebration on Sunday, June 8<sup>th</sup>. Exalted Ruler Frank Hunt, Elks Lodge #1 officers and several organizations performed the Massing of the Colours with the dignity and respect that "old Glory" justly deserves. Volunteers, volunteers, volunteers, setting up the room for the ceremony, setting up the dining areas, preparing the collation for the approximate 125 attendees and then serving the masses.... true Elks who

stepped up without fanfare to make this a memorable occasion.

June 14<sup>th</sup> was not only Flag Day, it was also the 269<sup>th</sup> "birthday" of the U.S. Army and the date of the SE District Veterans Committee's annual BBQ/picnic at St. Albans VA Hospital. Twenty Elk members from: New York Lodge #1, Brooklyn-Queensborough Lodge #878, Hicksville Lodge #1931 and New Hyde Park-North Shore Lodge #2107 hosted 87 attendees at this year's event. Member Lodges donated food, drink, musical entertainment and TLC as waiters and waitresses to the hospitalized veterans.

In the past I have asked for volunteers to come to either our monthly breakfast social and/or our monthly bingo night at St. Albans VA Hospital. Those who volunteer experience a reward of satisfaction when the veterans express their gratitude for our presence.

Each year New York Lodge #1 invites the patients from five area VA hospitals to attend a dinner/show. It requires a tremendous effort with many weeks of rehearsal for those in the musical revue. Lodge members turn it up a notch the night of this event with volunteers setting up the banquet hall, cooking the meals, serving the veterans and attending to their needs.

Mr. John Jablonski, a Korean War Veteran handed me a letter in which he expressed in writing what many other veterans have verbalized to me and the other Elk volunteers through-out the years. Mr. Jablonskii has given both verbal and written permission to publish this letter in order to convey to the Elks the importance of reaching out to our hospitalized veterans and how much this means to them. A photo-copy of this letter follows the conclusion of the month's Veterans Tale column.

To all members, enjoy your vacations as Lodge activities wind down for the summer. We continue to have our monthly breakfast socials and bingo during the summer months.

Lodge members (and the public as well) can look forward to our two annual fund raising events: The Italian Buffet Dinner on Friday, October  $10^{th}$  and The Veterans Pancake Breakfast on Sunday, November  $2^{nd}$ . These fundraisers help offset some of the expenses incurred when we serve our veterans at St. Albans and when the Lodge hosts its annual dinner/show for those hospitalized in five area hospitals. 
