
July 4<sup>th</sup> we are celebrating the birth of our **Country**. Let us remember our military that are in harm's way at this time.

## PROPOSED BY-LAWS AND HOUSE RULES AMENDMENTS New York Lodge No. 1

# The following proposed By-Laws and House Rules Amendments will be voted on at the Lodge meeting of July 16.

1. Proposition to add a \$25 Associate Membership fee.

Article X, Section 2 will be amended to add paragraph (d) ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP –" Each Associate Member shall pay an annual fee in the amount of \$25.00 in advance."

2. Proposition to change the meeting nights in July, August and December.

Article IV, Section 1 currently reads, "The regular Lodge meetings of this Lodge shall be held on the first and third Thursday of each month throughout the year, except in the months of July and August, in which the Lodge shall meet on the third Thursday."

The proposal is the amend this section to read, "The regular Lodge meetings of this Lodge shall be held on the first and third Thursday of each month throughout the year, except in the months of July, August and December, in which the Lodge shall meet on the first Thursday."

3. Proposition to authorize the use of the SHORTENED RITUAL, at the discretion of the Exalted Ruler.

The proposition is to add Article IV-A: Exemplification of Rituals, Section 1 to read as follows, "The Officers of this Lodge are authorized to use alternative forms of the Opening, Closing, and Initiatory Rituals as approved by the Grand Lodge. At any time, the Lodge may utilize the original Rituals. The Presiding Officer of the meeting and/or Initiation Ritual shall determine which form (*original or shortened*) will be used during that meeting."

4. Proposition to permit use of a Degree Team for the Initiatory Ritual

The proposition is to add Article VI, Section 9 to read as follows, "The Degree Team shall consist of Members of the Lodge, especially qualified in the rendition of the Initiatory Ritual appointed by the Exalted Ruler with the approval of the Lodge, and shall perform the Initiatory Ritual from memory. All elected and appointed Officers shall have the right to be a part of the Degree Team at their elected and appointed station."

5. Proposition to reduce the Reinstatement Fee from \$15 to \$1 in the months of June and July.

The proposition is to add the following paragraph to Article X, Section 4, "During the two (2) consecutive months of June and July of each year, the fee for reinstatement in this Lodge of a Member stricken from the rolls of this Lodge for non-payment of dues shall be one (1) dollar."

6. Proposition to permit the Treasurer to pay recurring bills upon approval of the Board of Trustees.

The proposition is to add a new Section 2 to Article XIII to read as follows, "The Treasurer may be recurring bills upon the approval of the Board of Trustees (or Board of Directors as may be applicable) without obtaining prior Lodge approval. Any such payment shall be reported at the next Lodge meeting."

7. Proposition to move the provision that all checks issued by the Treasurer must be signed by the Treasurer and a designated Trustee.

Article V. Sec. 5, currently reads, in part, "It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to receive all the Lodge moneys from the Secretary, giving him a receipt therefor; and, except as otherwise provided by By-Laws, he shall be the Treasurer of all Committees of the Lodge, and shall handle all funds of all Committees and of every activity of the Lodge; pay all bills against the Lodge as ordered thereby on vouchers signed by the Exalted Ruler and Secretary; keeping a correct account, under their proper dates, of the amounts and sources of receipts and the amounts and purposes of disbursements, taking proper vouchers for the various items thereof. He shall designate at least two members of the Board of Trustees to co-sign all checks, and all checks must be signed by the Treasurer and one of the designated Trustees. The Trustees so designated shall be approved by the Lodge and give bond in the same amount as required of the Treasurer. If a member of the Board of Trustees is an immediate family member of the Treasurer, he may not be designated as a signatory. In an emergency whereby the Treasurer is incapacitated and cannot sign checks, then checks may be signed by two of the designated Trustees."

The proposal is the amend Article V, Sec. 5 to remove the underlined section and add that as Article XIII, Section 3 to read as follows, "The Treasurer shall designate at least two members of the Board of Trustees (or Board of Directors as may be applicable) to co-sign all checks, and all checks must be signed by the Treasurer and one of the designees. The designees shall be approved by the Lodge and give bond in the same amount as required of the Treasurer. An immediate family member of the Treasurer may not be designated as a signatory. In an emergency whereby the Treasurer is incapacitated and cannot sign checks, then checks may be signed by two of the designees."

#### **HOUSE RULES REVISION**

1. <u>Proposition to add a new house rule regarding alcohol service to intoxicated members or guests</u>

The proposition is to add the following as rule #15 and renumber all subsequent rules: The service of alcohol will be provided to Lodge members and their guests only during regularly scheduled hours or during special events or parties. At any time, if a Lodge member or guest appears intoxicated or is approaching intoxication, the bartender will refuse to serve additional alcoholic beverages to that person. The House Committee or any Lodge officer may enforce this rule.


