

This movie was recently shown at “**The Museum of American Armor**”. **PSVP Frank T Hunt** attended the movie showing with his dad, Air Force, WWII Veteran **PER Frank L Hunt** who was an honoree at this event. Each WWII honoree was presented a

proclamation for his/her service by **Nassau County Executive Ed Mangano**.

The “**Honor Flight**” flies WWII Veterans to the WWII Monument in Washington, D.C. for “their day in the sun”. Sixteen million men and women served in the military during WWII.
