The BPOE Grand Lodge designated by resolution June 14<sup>th</sup> as "Flag Day" in 1907. The Grand Lodge of the Order adopted mandatory observance of the occasion by every Lodge in 1911, and that requirement continues.

The Elks prompted President Woodrow Wilson to recognize the Order's observance of Flag Day for its patriotic expression. Flag Day was officially established by the Proclamation of President Wilson on May 30, 1916.

Come join us on Sunday June 8, 2014 for the "Annual Flag Day Service" at New York Lodge #1, BPOE. The tribute to "Old Glory" will begin at 5PM with a light collation to follow.



The annual veterans' dinner show held on Wednesday April 23<sup>rd</sup> was attended by 151 guests from four area hospitals: Manhattan, Brooklyn, St. Albans and Northport. Twenty-five New York Lodge #1 brothers and sisters along with six non-Elk members contributed their time and opened up their hearts to our hospitalized guests. Peter Gong and Anthony Cipriano were the color guard for the opening ceremony. Admiral Richard LiBrandi along with the Sea Rangers served as the color guard for the closing of the evening's festivities. The fund-raising dinner show was held the following Friday, April 25<sup>th</sup> with the proceeds from the 93 attendees to be used to offset the expenses incurred when the Lodge hosted our honored veteran guests.
