I recently attended a VA/VS meeting at which we were informed that Viet Nam Era Veterans constitute the largest segment of the hospitalized Veterans in VA

facilities. This year the Federal Government is recognizing Viet Nam Era Veterans with a nationwide awareness,"Viet Nam 50th Anniversary Commemoration". During the Viet Nam Era (August 5, 1964-May 7, 1975) 9,087,000 military personnel served on active duty which represented 9.7% of their generation. A total of 2,709,918 Americans served in Viet Nam with over 58,000 U.S. military fatal casualties there. Approximately 1/3 of all U.S. Veterans who served in Viet Nam are estimated to be alive today.

Click on a name and it will give details of the Veteran's death, a picture or at least a biography and medals. I hope that everyone who receives this appreciates what those who served in Viet Nam sacrificed for our country in a turbulent time in our nation's history. 
