The "Cold War Certificate" may be awarded to any current NY State citizen or a person who was a NY State citizen while serving in the Armed Forces of the United States during the Cold War period, 2 September 1945 to 26 December 1991 whose service was honorable.

"Honorable" (Honorable Discharge) or

"Under Honorable Conditions" (General Discharge under Honorable Conditions). This certificate may be rewarded posthumously to a designated survivor of the deceased. A Division of Military and Naval Affairs form (DMNA Form 105) may be obtained in the DMNA website: http://dmna.ny.gov/ forms/dmna form pdf.


