

### **Scholarship Corner update:**

The 2018 Most Valuable Student scholarship contest is open to any high school senior who is a US Citizen.

Applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership, and financial need. **Applications for the 2018 contest will be** available online starting September 1, 2017. The 2018 MVS application deadline is November 27, 2017.

<u>Elks National Foundation 2018 Legacy Awards Application</u> Before registering to apply, please verify that you meet the eligibility criteria.

- 1. Are you the child or grandchild (or step-child, step-grandchild, or legal ward) of a living Elk who joined the order on or before April 1, 2015, or a charter member of a Lodge that was instituted on or after April 1, 2015? Your Elk sponsor must also be a paid-up member through March 31, 2018. Great-grandchildren are not eligible. If your parent and grandparent are both Elk members, you should apply through the parent's Elks Lodge.
- 2. Are you a high school senior?
- 3. Are you planning to attend an accredited U.S. school, college or university? (Note: Applicants from Guam, Panama, Puerto Rico and the Philippines may apply Legacy Awards toward schools, colleges or universities in their respective homes.)
- 4. Do you plan to take the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or the American College Test (ACT) by December 31, 2017?

If you answered yes to all the questions above, you can now register to start the application process. Your application must be submitted no later than 11:59 a.m. Central Time on February 2, 2018.
